- Registered students must use the site www.usalearns.org/class, or we will not be able to track their coursework and hours of involvement.
- We provide students with login directions in a step-by-step introduction document when they email their online teacher.
- The State has set the hours of credit that can be given for USA Learns coursework:
 - beginning students earn 2.5 hours of credit for each unit completed;
 - intermediate and advanced students earn 2 hours for each unit completed.
- Students who “jump around” and do some work, but who do not complete any full units will, unfortunately, receive 0 hours.
